



2009 ASCE SAN DIEGO YMF STUDENT ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

The San Diego Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers Younger Member Forum (ASCE YMF) is collecting applications for the purpose of awarding three student scholarships to those interested in pursuing a degree in civil engineering or related field at a four-year university and a transferring community college student. A total of three scholarships will be awarded:

- 2 ~ **\$1,000** scholarships will be awarded to a University of California San Diego (UCSD) or San Diego State University (SDSU) graduate or undergraduate student
- 1 ~ **\$500** scholarship will be awarded to a San Diego Region community college student transferring to a four-year university

ELIGIBILITY

Graduate or undergraduate students:

Must be enrolled in a civil engineering or related field during the 2009-2010 academic year at UCSD or SDSU. International students are also eligible. Students completing their education in Spring/Summer 2009 are not eligible. The award money is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution.

Community college transfer students:

Must be transferring to a four-year university and enrolled in a civil engineering or related field for the 2009-2010 academic year. International students are also eligible. The award money is to be used for formal education expenses at the intended educational institution.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- One page application form (attached)
- Resume
- For university students only:
 - Official transcript or
 - SIGNED letter from an academic advisor (with advisor's contact information) stating number of units/classes taken towards civil engineering or related major.
- For community college transfer students only:
 - Official Transcript or
 - Unofficial Transcript SIGNED by a college counselor (with counselor's contact information), accompanied with a letter which states student's major and number of units/classes taken towards transferring to a university.

Note: upon receiving scholarship, proof of enrollment to a university is required



- Essay (one-page maximum, typed)
 - ***“What are your plans and goals for your education and career in Civil Engineering and why do you deserve this scholarship?”***

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Prepare the following items for submission as outlined in the “Application Requirement” section:
 - a. Application Form (signed)
 - b. Resume
 - c. Transcript or signed letter from academic advisor/counselor – see different requirements for university and community college transfer students
 - d. Typewritten essay
